

History of the Metro Atlanta Chapter (SSU) Savannah State University National Alumni Association

During the early 1950s, a small group of Savannah State College graduates living in the Atlanta area began gathering informally in their homes to socialize, fellowship, and reminisce about their days at Savannah State College. As their bond and shared purpose grew, these alumni decided to formalize their efforts and began laying the foundation for a local alumni chapter. Their vision became reality when the Metro Atlanta Chapter was officially organized and chartered by the Savannah State College National Alumni Association in 1960.

Since its founding, the Metro Atlanta Chapter has remained steadfast in its commitment to supporting Savannah State University by building fellowship among alumni, students, and supporters in the Metro Atlanta community. The chapter actively promotes the university's academic mission by participating in student recruitment and providing critical financial assistance through scholarships for Atlanta-area students attending SSU.

Over the decades, the chapter's impact has been substantial. In 2015, \$20,000 in scholarships were awarded, followed by \$26,000 in 2023. Since 1990, the chapter has awarded over \$350,000 in scholarships to deserving students in the Metro Atlanta area, helping to change lives and shape futures.

The chapter's efforts have not gone unnoticed. In 2023, the Metro Atlanta Chapter was named Chapter of the Year by the Savannah State University National Alumni Association. In 2024, the chapter was also honored as the grand prize winner of the KQ Communications Small Business Reboot contest, receiving a professional branding makeover valued at \$10,000. This new branding ensures the chapter will be recognized not only by its impactful work—but also by a strong visual identity—as it continues to grow and reach new heights.

Currently, chapter meetings are held monthly on the 4th Saturday at 1:00 PM, either via Zoom or in person at the Sigma Zeta Foundation located at 2526 Delowe Drive, East Point, Georgia 30344.

Since 1960, numerous SSU trailblazers have proudly served as officers and leaders of the Metro Atlanta Chapter, continuing a legacy of excellence and dedication to our beloved University by the Sea.

DR. JERMAINE WHIRL

15TH PRESIDENT

SAVANNAH STATE UNIVERSITY

Dr. Jermaine Whirl, an Aspen Fellow, is a nationally sought-after, award-winning authority in workforce & higher education. He currently serves as the 15th president of Savannah State University and past president of Augusta Technical College. During his tenure at Augusta Tech, he completed a full-rebrand of the institution, implemented a new five-year strategic plan, established 5 new academic schools, established a new School of Health Sciences Campus at Summerville in partnership with Piedmont Augusta (the first and only two-year healthcare school operating in a hospital), became the first institution of higher education in Augusta to be selected an Amazon Choice Partner, established the Augusta Advantage Transfer Program with Augusta University, established the institution's first nuclear apprenticeship program with the Savannah River Nuclear School, launched the state's first Global Cyber Summit, helped the college achieve its 10-year reaffirmation for SACSCOC accreditation, established the Jim Hudson Center for Automotive Institute (65,000 square feet – the largest automotive training facility in Georgia), established the Greater Augusta Banking and Finance Institute, launched the institution's first middle & high school STEM summer camps, secured \$4.4m of state funding to create a CDL Truck Driving Range in McDuffie County, established Accelerate Augusta- a \$2.3 million incubator- microenterprise center in partnership with the Downtown Development Authority of Augusta with congressional dollars from U.S. Senator Raphael Warnock, established a ten-year sponsored program for Accelerate Augusta and ATC financial literacy programming and debit card with SRP Federal Credit Union, obtained the college's first ever million dollar gift (obtained three separate million dollar gifts in 8 months), obtained a \$1m gift to name the college's first academic school (T.R. Reddy School of Advanced Manufacturing & Engineering Technology) helped to recruit the largest freshmen class in the past three years (1,600 new students) while increasing enrollment to 5,900 credit and 6,400 noncredit students, co-chaired the Biden-Harris Workforce Hub Augusta Initiative, and most recently partnered with Augusta National Golf Course (Master's Tournament) and First Tee of Augusta to revitalize the Augusta Municipal Golf Course to establish the nation's first corridor of golf education in partnership with the City of Augusta.

In the last year alone he's been awarded the Paragon Award for new presidents from Phi Theta Kappa, the Leadership Award from the Greater Augusta Black Chamber of Commerce, the Man of the Year award from the Success Team Non-Profit Organization, Men of Excellence Award from Bethel AME Church, Georgia Southern University's George and Lucy Armstrong Alumni Award, Man of the Year Award from the New Bethlehem Community Center, Man of Excellence Award from Bethel AME Church Augusta, Soul Awakening Award of Excellence from Perry Broadcasting of Augusta, been inducted in the Georgia Titan 100 Hall of Fame, a 2024 Georgia Trend 40 Under 40 honoree, a 2025 Georgia Trend Notable Georgian honoree, and was an inaugural member of the Georgia Trend 500 most influential leaders in Georgia. He's a graduate of the Executive Leadership Augusta Forum, Leadership Columbia County, Furman University's Diversity Leadership Institute (DLI), the SC Economic Development Institute, Leadership Greenville Class 44, and Leadership Gwinnett Class of 2016. He is also the only college president in the United States selected to serve a three-year term on the U.S. Inaugural 21st Century Energy Workforce Advisory Board that provides guidance to the Secretary of Energy. Dr. Whirl also serves other regional and national boards, taskforces, and councils for organizations such as TD Bank, the Federal Reserve Bank of Atlanta, Queensborough National Bank, and The Warrior Alliance.

Before accepting the presidency at ATC, Dr. Whirl served as the Vice President for Learning and Workforce Development at Greenville Technical College. In this role, he served as the chief academic and continuing education officer, and he was responsible for the leadership of the college's credit and non-credit programs serving approximately 20,000 students a year in five locations. He also served as the college's Vice President for Economic Development and Corporate Training where he served as the official economic development liaison to the Greenville Area Development Corporation, Upstate SC Alliance, and the SC Department of Commerce helping to recruit over 20 companies over a four-year span. Dr. Whirl holds the special distinction of being the first and only chief academic officer in the SC Technical College System to author a bachelor's degree with full approval by the SC Commission on Higher Education.

Additional administrative experience includes serving Gwinnett Technical College as Dean of both the School of Business Sciences and School of Art & Design; Dean of Adult Education at Savannah Technical College; full-time faculty member within the Parker College of Business Administration at Georgia Southern University, and full-time faculty member at East Georgia State College. Dr. Whirl also held adjunct faculty positions at Charleston Southern University, South University, and Toccoa Falls College in the areas of business administration, economics, and leadership. His higher education career began at Winthrop University where he first served as a tutor to provisionally admitted students in the LEAP program, and he then served in the office of alumni relations where he led the student alumni council.

She went on to build her reputation in Washington, D.C., at Fox 5 News (WTTG/WDCB), working across sales, creative development, and special programming. She then joined Fox Sports Networks, managing national and regional sports programming for nearly a decade while also hosting weekends on Atlanta's Kiss 104.1 FM.

"I've learned that the true power of communication lies in its ability to convey authenticity. Whether scripting stories, hosting shows, or advocating for justice, my journey has been about crafting spaces where voices, true and unfiltered, lead to impactful change and deeper understanding."

In Los Angeles, April co-founded CBJ Productions, producing Black-centered stories in theatre, television, and digital media, and created the podcast Soul Titty, spotlighting R&B/Soul artists and culture. She later joined Univision Los Angeles as Sales Analyst & Planner, where she also co-founded Kulture, the company's Black & Indigenous People Global Inclusion group.

A proud Savannah State University alumna, April also serves as Communications Chair for the Junior League of DeKalb County and mentors HBCU students pursuing careers in media. She is an active member of W.I.S.E. (Women in Sports & Events), the Los Angeles Urban League Young Professionals, and the Savannah State University National Alumni Association (SSUNAA).
